If you force me to sign, § 543.005 requires you to  
promptly release me as soon as I sign.  
I will comply with clearly stated lawful orders.**

# FOR USE IN TEXAS ONLY

**Place the other side against window so police can read it.**

**Do not speak at all. Not one word. Record everything.**

Do not open the window unless they threaten to break it.

Keep your hands where the officer can see them.

Show them your license and insurance through the window. You may be able to show insurance on a mobile device.

You are required to “exhibit” them. But you don’t have to hand them over.

So don’t open your window.

In Texas, if you refuse to sign a ticket the police will probably arrest you. As quickly as possible roll the window down, sign and hand back to the officer, then roll your window back up. §543.005 requires them to promptly release you from custody once you sign.

Police are allowed to stop you at a checkpoint, but you are not required to open your window.

Do not fight or physically resist. If the officer clearly states a lawful order, it is safer to comply.
