**Please put any tickets under windshield wiper.
I am not required to sign - § 77-7-18 - § 77-7-20.
I do not have to hand over my license - § 53-3-217.
Thus I am NOT opening my window.
I will comply with clearly stated lawful orders.**

FOR USE IN UTAH ONLY

Place the other side against window so police can read it.

Do not speak at all. Not one word. Record everything.

Do not open the window unless they threaten to break it.

Keep your hands where the officer can see them.

In Utah, you are not required to sign a traffic ticket. If you refuse to sign a ticket, the police might arrest you anyway.

Police are allowed to stop you at a checkpoint, but you are not required to open your window.

Show them your license, registration and insurance through the window.

You are required to “display” them. But you don’t have to hand them over.

So don’t open your window.

Do not fight or physically resist. If the officer clearly states a lawful order, it is safer to comply.
