**Please put any tickets under windshield wiper.
I have to display my papers, not hand them to you.**

-- 625 ILCS 5/3-411; 5/6-112; 5/7-602

I am not required to sign: 725 ILCS 5/107-11,12

Thus I am NOT opening my window.

I will comply with clearly stated lawful orders.

FOR USE IN ILLINOIS ONLY

Place the other side against window so police can read it.

Do not speak at all. Not one word. Record everything.
Keep your hands where the officer can see them.

Show them your license and other requested documents through the window.

You are required to “display” documents. But you don’t have to hand them over.

You are not required to sign tickets.
So don’t open your window.

However, if you are from another state they can arrest you if you don’t sign.

Police are allowed to stop you at a checkpoint, but you are not required to open your window.

Never fight or physically resist. If the officer clearly states a lawful order, it is safer to comply.
