I WANT MY LAWYER

§16-112 requires me to “display” or “exhibit” my papers. You can see them through my closed window.

Please hold any tickets and your card up to the window. I will digitally sign tickets (§21-114) and e-mail to you or to media@mdsp.org.

Thus I am NOT opening my window.

I will comply with clearly stated lawful orders.

FOR USE IN MARYLAND ONLY

Place the other side against window so police can read it.

Do not speak at all. Not one word. Record everything.

Keep your hands where the officer can see them.

Show them your license and other requested documents through the window.

The law might require you to “surrender” documents but showing them should be enough. Refusal to do so is a simple ticket. That ticket is much less serious than what might happen in you do open your window.

You are required to sign tickets. However, Maryland allows you to digitally sign documents. When the officer puts the ticket against your window, take a picture, use the SignEasy app, and e-mail it to whatever e-mail address he or she shows you, or to media@mdsp.org.

Police are allowed to stop you at a checkpoint, but you are not required to open your window.

Never fight or physically resist. If the officer clearly states an order, it is safer to comply.
