I WANT MY LAWYER

§47-6-112 requires me to “display” my papers. You can inspect them through my closed window.

Please hold any tickets and your card up to the window. I will digitally sign tickets and e-mail to you.

15 U.S. Code § 7001(a)(1).

Thus I am NOT opening my window.

I will comply with clearly stated lawful orders.

FOR USE IN OKLAHOMA ONLY

Place the other side against window so police can read it.

Do not speak at all. Not one word. Record everything.

Keep your hands where the officer can see them.

Show them your license and other requested documents through the window.

The law does not require you to hand over documents. You are only required to “display” your license. The law allows police to “inspect” some documents but they can do that through the window.

You are required to sign tickets. However, federal law allows you to digitally sign documents. When the officer puts the ticket against your window, take a picture, use an app like SignEasy to sign on you phone, and e-mail it to whatever e-mail address he or she shows you.

Police are allowed to stop you at a checkpoint, but you are not required to open your window.

Never fight or physically resist. If the officer clearly states an order, it is safer to comply.
