**I will comply with clearly stated lawful orders.**

# FOR USE IN ARIZONA ONLY

**Place the other side against window so police can read it.**

**Do not speak at all. Not one word. Record everything.**

**Keep your hands where the officer can see them.**

Show them your license and other requested documents through the window.

The law does not require you to “surrender” documents. Showing them is enough.

You are not required to sign tickets. So don't open your window.

Police are allowed to stop you at a checkpoint, but you are not required to open your window.

Never fight or physically resist.

If the officer clearly states an order, it is safer to comply.
