

I REMAIN SILENT

NO SEARCHES

I WANT MY LAWYER

MCL 257.311 requires me to display my papers.

You can see them through my closed window.

I am not required to sign any tickets. MCL 764.9f.

Thus I am NOT opening my window.

Please put any tickets under my windshield wiper.

I will comply with clearly stated lawful orders.

FOR USE IN MICHIGAN ONLY

Place the other side against window so police can read it.

Do not speak at all. Not one word. Record everything.

Keep your hands where the officer can see them.

Show them your license and other requested documents through the window. The license has to be visible to the officer and readable. If your window is tinted or too high, then you may be required to hand documents over. Michigan v. Heldt, 2003.

The law does not require you to sign tickets.

Police are allowed to stop you at a checkpoint, but you are not required to open your window.

Never fight or physically resist. If the officer clearly states an order, it is safer to comply.
