I REMAIN SILENT NO SEARCHES I WANT MY LAWYER

Please put any tickets under windshield wiper.

I will show my papers, but not hand them over. §302.181(3)

There is no law or rule requiring me to sign tickets. However, if you insist I will digitally sign. Please place tickets up against the window.

Thus I am NOT opening my window. I will comply with clearly stated lawful orders.

FOR USE IN MISSOURI ONLY

Place the other side against window so police can read it.

Do not speak at all. Not one word. Record everything.

Keep your hands where the officer can see them.

Show them your license and other requested documents through the window. You are not required to hand them over so don't open the window. State v. Campbell, 564 S.W.2d 867 (1978)

The law is not clear about whether you are required to sign tickets. If the officer insists, you can digitally sign with an app like SignEasy.

Police are allowed to stop you at a checkpoint, but you are not required to open your window.

Never fight or physically resist.

If the officer clearly states an order, it is safer to comply.
